

WPK Central Committee Sends Open Letter to Foreign Political Parties

Pyongyang, September 25 (KCNA) -- The Central Committee of the Workers' Party of Korea (WPK) sent an open letter to foreign political parties on Sept. 24.

The letter extended friendly greetings to foreign political parties making efforts for the peace and security of the world and the social development and the wellbeing of the people.

It recalled that the chairman of the State Affairs Commission of the DPRK declared he would make the U.S. chief executive pay dearly for denying the existence of the DPRK, defaming it and talking rude nonsense calling for totally destroying it under the eyes of the world.

The statement of the chairman of the State Affairs Commission of the DPRK reflected the wrath and will of all the Party members and other people determined to fight against the U.S. imperialists to the last and finish them as they dared defame the dignity of the supreme leadership of the DPRK and revealed their attempt to plunge the Korean people into the crucible of a horrible nuclear war, the letter said, adding:

In order to realize the genuine international justice and to defend elementary right to existence of mankind, it is necessary to counter nukes of tyranny with the nuclear treasured sword of justice. This is the truth that the DPRK-U.S. confrontation teaches the world.

The Central Committee of the Workers' Party of Korea ardently appeals to foreign political parties valuing independence, justice and peace to turn out as one in the joint action and front to frustrate the U.S. reckless moves to plunge the world into the nuclear disaster.

Open Letter to Parliaments of Different Countries

Pyongyang, September 25 (KCNA) -- The Foreign Affairs Committee of the Supreme People's Assembly of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea sent an open letter to parliaments of different countries of the world on Sunday.

The letter said that Trump, president of the U.S. styling itself the "superpower", denied the existence of the DPRK, a dignified sovereign state, and spit out ignorant remarks of "total destruction" at the UN General Assembly, the greatest official diplomatic forum, stunning the world public.

The Foreign Affairs Committee of the Supreme People's Assembly of the DPRK the basic mission of which is to promote friendly and cooperation relations with all parliaments and peace-loving people, proceeding from the foreign policy of the Workers' Party of Korea regarding independence, peace and friendship as its idea, bitterly condemned the reckless remarks of Trump as an intolerable insult to the Korean people, a declaration of war against the DPRK and grave threats to the global peace.

The letter went on:

From the first day of his office Trump has conducted high-handed and arbitrary practices, scrapping international laws and agreements incurring his displeasure on the "U.S.-first principle", the height of American-style thinking way that it is best if the U.S. is well-off at the expense of the whole world.

The U.S. brought to their knees those countries devoid of principle, narrow-minded and selfish countries seeking after their interests only with nuclear stick and force and cooked up the illegal "resolution on sanctions against the DPRK" denying the elementary right to existence of the Korean people and checking normal development of economy in breach of

the inviolable UN Charter by abusing the UN Security Council. This is an intensive act of the revelation of the "U.S.-first principle".

Trump threatened to totally destroy the DPRK, dignified independent and sovereign state and nuclear power. This is the extreme act of threatening to totally destroying the whole world.

If Trump thinks that he would bring the DPRK, a nuclear power to its knees through nuclear war threat, it is a big miscalculation and ignorance.

The DPRK has emerged as a nuclear power true to its name as it has built the powerful arsenal of nukes and multifarious means of delivery of nuclear weapons by dint of self-reliance and self-development. The real enemy the nuclear force of the DPRK tries to match is a nuclear war itself.
